## Stark County Graduation Rates Continue to Rise – Canton South High School Graduates 100%; Massillon Achieves Greater Than 90% Graduation Rate

Celebration is appropriate in Stark County. The graduation rates continue to rise. On the 2003-2004 report card, 10 districts had achieved a 90% or greater graduation rate for the 2002-2003 school year and now on the 2006-2007 report card 15 districts are at 90% or better.
