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'College connectors' getting results in Stark County high schools



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Since 2007, college guides, also called college connectors, have helped Stark County high school students, counselors and principals overcome the barriers to post-secondary education. Some notable results:

- At Timken High School, the share of students entering college by the fall after graduation increased from 36 percent to 46 percent, with the total rising to 64 percent after two years.
- At McKinley High School, the share of students entering college by the fall after graduation rose from 60 percent to 63 percent, and 71 percent after two years.
- At Alliance High School, the share of students entering college by the fall after graduation increased from 37 percent to 44 percent, with 58 percent attending college after two years.
- At Massillon Washington High School, the share of students entering college by the fall after graduation increased from 57 percent to 62 percent, with 70 percent entering after two years.
