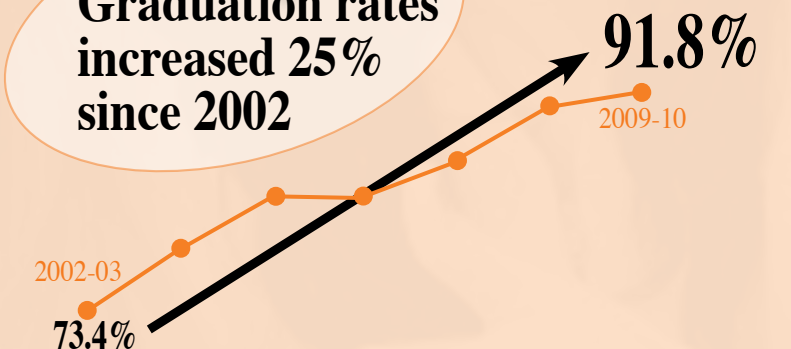
Our Goal: 100% High School Graduation

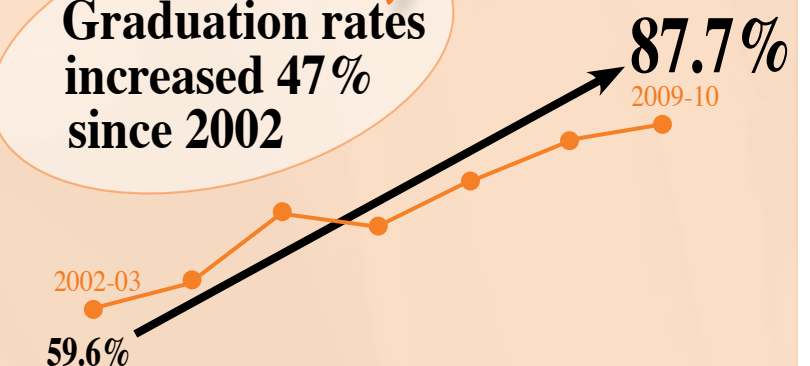

Graduation rates increased **47%** since 2002

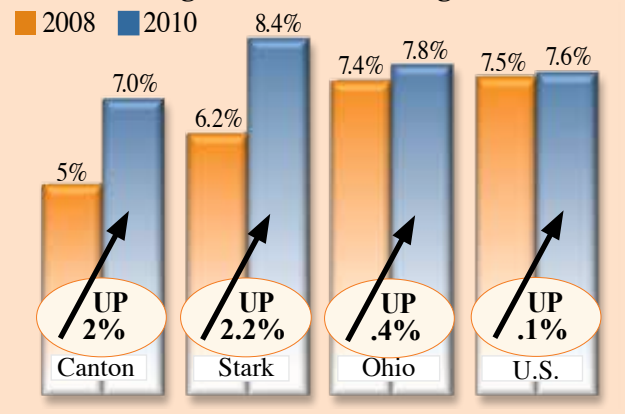

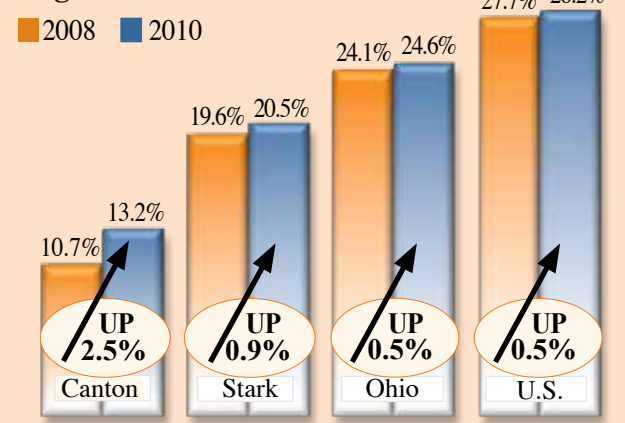
Our Goal: Increase Educational Attainment

Early College High School

Canton's Early College High School (CECHS) is an opportunity for students to earn both a diploma and an Associate Degree while in high school. Students are admitted regardless of prior academic performance and over half are minorities. Most will be the first in their families ever to go to college.

High School Based Dual Credit

High school based dual credit (HSBDC) courses are college courses taught by high school teachers who qualify as college adjuncts. Students can earn both high school and college credit for the same course. HSBDC reduces the cost of college and accelerates the time towards degree completion.
